

## “THE PROCESS”

- Contact me via phone or email: We can discuss your needs and get to know each other a little to make sure we are a good fit. We will then schedule an Initial Consultation.
- Preparation: We will consider different locations based on our discussion, or come up with different ideas for a home studio session. Please take pictures of walls you are considering for your finished images (or I can come over to your home and take pictures) as it has proved invaluable when it comes time to choosing products and images.
- The Session: Whether it’s on location or in the home studio – it will be fun! On location, we will chase the sun and the great light. We shoot until we get it right, there is no time limit.
- Sneak Peek: Within a day or so of the session, I will post one or two images on social media from the session – just to get you excited.
- Ordering Session: Within about two weeks of the shoot, I will have you come to my home to review your images in high definition or I will come to you. I will help you narrow down your choices and admire your beautiful portraits. This meeting will take approximately an hour and is designed for you to place your order. Please bring with you anyone necessary in helping you choose the images.
- Delivery and Installation: Once your products arrive, I will let you know and coordinate delivery.
- What to bring? The best photographs are made when everyone is enjoying themselves. Fun accessories like hats, balloons, balls, bubbles or lollipops are great for kids. A favorite toy and/or blanket also work well; anything that excites your child. Bringing snacks, drinks, wipes and a hairbrush or comb is useful.

- What to wear? This will depend on the occasion and feel we want to capture. Coordinating outfits generally look the best, not matching ones. Avoid any logos or text on clothing, something of solid color works best. Bring a change of clothes, if desired.
- What time shall I schedule my shoot? If you are taking photographs with your children, take your child's schedule into consideration. As a parent you know when your child is at his or her best. Children's portrait sessions should be scheduled for a time of day when they are well rested and alert. The best times of day lighting wise are either early morning or late afternoon, when the sun is overhead. Regardless, I am prepared for any lighting condition.
- How long will it take to view the images? Allow up to two weeks. It usually only takes one week.
- When will I receive the prints? You will receive the prints approximately 1 month after you place your order.
- What if I want to order additional prints? You may order prints directly through us. Just email us the image number and size of the image you would like. We do not hold onto images forever so if you would like additional images, please let us know as soon as possible.
